Contemporary Models

CANTONI'S NEW DESIGNER MODELS for 1065 Midtown showcase sophisticated urban living with a dose of playfulness. For the 37th-floor penthouse (the Piedmont Residence), designer Pamela Satterly brought in contemporary furniture with soft and whimsical lines, such as the serpentine Menlo Park sectional, to contrast with the architectural skyline. The 2,819-square-foot, three-bedroom, three-and-a-half-bath condo features sweeping panoramic views, a high-gloss white Axis desk, black Gatsby leather lounge chairs and black-and-white limited-edition abstracts with red frames.

For the 2,289-square-foot model at 1065 Midtown, called

the Ansley Residence, designer Mercedes Williams took inspiration from Midtown's traditional and cutting-edge design as well as Atlanta's film industry. Williams selected furniture—such as the white leather Chagall sofa and polished-chrome and crystal Paramount chandelier. He paired those items with furniture and accessories in a curvilinear fashion, such as the kidney-shaped glass top of the Quantiste II cocktail table and the Chandler rocking chair.

The residences, situated on the top 11 floors of the Loews Atlanta Hotel, offers prospective buyers a lock-and-leave lifestyle with all the amenities of a hotel from the heart of Midtown.
